NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- A separate entry blank must be completed for **each dog entered**. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A, B, Instinct, HT, PT, & HIC) and stock you intend to enter for each dog. (HT, PT, HIC on goats only)
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order in Test Classes. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test or trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- The 4CHAT Treasurer will mail any and all refund checks after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test or Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, extreme weather conditions, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded in the case of duplicate entries or any other cause beyond the control of the club after the closing of entries.
- A tub for cooling-off will be provided.
- Please bring your own chairs.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.
- No telephone, fax, online entries or credit card payments will be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The 4CHAT Treasurer will add a \$20.00 collection to the amount of each returned check.

I, (we) acknowledge that the “rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows” and the “rules for Herding Tests & Trials” have been made available to me (us) and that I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies,

I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in this event of serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. Disaster and Emergency Plans for People and Dogs at this Herding Event

Fire: Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.

Thunderstorms and Lightning: Should lightning be observed, all personnel and animals should move or be moved to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.

Mass Disaster Plan – Tornado: In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.

Personal Injury or Health Problems: Dial 911 for the Emergency Response Team/Ambulance, or see above A First Aid Kit for minor injuries will be at the event site.

Dog Injuries: VETERINARIAN (OFF SITE) see above. A dog First Aid Kit will be at the event site

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL

FROM TULSA: Take US-412 to the Cimarron Tpke - Go 43.8 mi on US- 412 [Cimarron Tpke][West] to the US-177/Stillwater/Ponca City exit - Exit Right then turn Left (North) onto US-177 - Go 20.6 mi to US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and turn Right (East) - Go 3.1 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM OKLAHOMA CITY: Take I-35 (North) approx. 86 mi to the US-60 /Tonkawa/Ponca City exit(214) - Exit Right (East) onto US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and go approx. 18.6 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM (WICHITA) KANSAS/OKLAHOMA STATE LINE: Take I-35 (South) approx. 20.9 mi to the US-60/Tonkawa/Ponca City exit(214) - Exit Left (East) onto US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and go approx. 18.6 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM (US-75) AT BARTLESVILLE OK: Turn (West) on US-60 (SE Adams Blvd.) - Go 3.7 mi and turn Right (North) onto US-60 [SR-123] then Left (West) onto US-60 [Bartlesville Rd.] and stay on US-60 62.8 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Left (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.
