NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- > A separate entry blank must be completed for **each dog entered**. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A, B, Instinct, HT, PT, & HIC) and stock you intend to enter for each dog. (HT, PT, HIC on goats only)
- ➤ Bitches in season will be permitted to run, but will be moved to the end of the running order in Test Classes. Please notify the Event Secretary if your bitch is in season.
- > Entry fees will be refunded to alternates who decline to be placed on the alternate list. Also, entry fees of alternates who do not participate in the test or trial will be refunded. Entry fees will not be refunded to a scheduled entrant who is absent on the day of the event unless an alternate is present and runs in the place of the absent dog.
- The 4CHAT Treasurer will mail any and all refund checks after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- > It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- > Owners or their Agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dog(s) at the Test or Trial arena. Judges are not required to wait for dogs.
- > Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Fire: Dial 911. All dogs should be crated or leashed securely. Owners, Handlers and Spectators must keep the main driveway clear so Emergency vehicles will have suitable access to the property.

Thunderstorms and Lightning: Should lightning be observed, all personnel and animals should move or be moved to the safety of their vehicles or covered buildings until the danger has passed.

Mass Disaster Plan – Tornado: In the event of a tornado, dogs should be leashed and all people and their dogs should proceed to the lowest point on the property until the danger has passed.

Personal Injury or Heath Problems: Dial 911 for the Emergency Response Team/Ambulance, or see above A First Aid Kit for minor injuries will be at the event site.

FROM TULSA: Take US-412 to the Cimarron Tpke - Go 43.8 mi on US-412 [Cimarron Tpke][West] to the US-177/Stillwater/Ponca City exit - Exit Right then turn Left (North) onto US-177 - Go 20.6 mi to US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and turn Right (East) - Go 3.1 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM OKLAHOMA CITY: Take I-35 (North) approx. 86 mi to the US-60

/Tonkawa/Ponca City exit(214) - Exit Right (East) onto US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and go appox. 18.6 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM (WICHITA) KANSAS/OKLAHOMA STATE LINE: Take I-35 (South) approx. 20.9 mi to the US-60/Tonkawa/Ponca City exit(214) - Exit Left (East) onto US-60 (do not take US-60 business) and go appox. 18.6 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Right (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.

FROM (US-75) AT BARTLESVILLE OK: Turn (West) on US-60 (SE Adams Blvd.) - Go 3.7 mi and turn Right (North) onto US-60 [SR-123] then Left (West) onto US-60 [Bartlesville Rd.] and stay on US-60 62.8 mi to Hunt Rd. and turn Left (South) - Go 2.5 mi and Turn Left (North) onto Wilde Rd. - Go approx. 1/3 mi to Trial Site.
